

To William Martin, a Nolle Prosequi, on account of a charge of manslaughter, pending against him in Baltimore City Court, of which he has been found guilty. (See Parrow Record)

Wednesday July 5th 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Durbin or order seventy five dollars for one quarter salary as Auditor at Frederick due the first Instant.

Saturday July 8th 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John James Audubon, or order, three hundred dollars, for Plates of the Birds of America furnished to the State Library, by order of the Joint Library Committee, under Resolution of the General Assembly, & Certificate of the Librarian.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Alexander Sumwalt or order ten dollars for repairs of the stair way leading to the Committee room and Court of Appeals Chamber, under Resolution of the General Assembly, & Certificate of Richard W. Gice and Washington G. Ficks.

Tuesday July 11th 1837.

His Excellency the Governor granted a Nolle Prosequi to Caroline Wright (Mulatto) on account of a charge of Felony pending against her in Baltimore City Court, of which she has been found guilty. (See Parrow Record)

Thursday July 13th 1837

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James W. Welch or order fifty eight dollars & seventy five cents for publishing in the Snow Hill Sentinel Sunday Lanes of the last General Assembly, by direction of the Clerk of the Council under Resolution of the General Assembly, \$50, and for publishing in the same paper the Proclamation of the Governor fixing the time of Election of Representatives in Congress \$8.75, & amount proved.

Monday July 17th 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George Keating, or order fifty dollars for publishing in the Madisonian Sunday Lanes, by direction of the Clerk of the Council, under Resolution of the General Assembly, & amount proved.

His Excellency the Governor granted a Nolle Prosequi to Samuel Thompson on account of a charge of passing counterfeit promissory notes.
