

The following message to the General Assembly was sent by Thomas
Cullbreth Clerk of the Council viz

Executive Department
Annapolis January 31 1838

Gentlemen of the Senate, and
of the House of Delegates: We herewith lay before you a report of the
gentlemen employed by the Executive to superintend the building of a new
Tobacco Warehouse. Upon examination of the Law providing for build-
ing the Warehouse, we do not think that it authorizes us to have the new
street paved, or the pavements of the old street repaired, and as it is man-
ifest, that the Warehouse cannot be conveniently used until this work
is done, we submit the matter for your consideration, and such action upon
it as you may think proper. With the highest consideration, we have the
Honor to remain, your Obedt. Servts.
