

His Excellency also granted a Pardon to Edward Lane, jr on account of keeping a Harbinger, for which he was convicted in Baltimore City Court at February Term 1838, and for which he was sentenced to thirty days imprisonment. (See Pardon Record)

Saturday March 10th 1838.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay \$487.00 or order four hundred and forty eight dollars eleven cents for one years ground Rent of Tobacco Warehouse lot up to the first of August next.

His Excellency the Governor granted Nolle Prosequis to Francis B. Digges, John A. Matthews and Zachariah Lloyd, on account of separate presentments pending against them in Charles County for assault & battery on the body of Elkanah Smithson. (See Pardon Record)

Monday March 12th 1838.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Justin Peice or order twelve dollars for a copy of Mitchell's Map of the World, and order for the State Library, by the Authority of the Joint Library Committee & Certificate of the Librarian.

Tuesday March 13th 1838.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order one hundred and forty nine dollars forty three cents, for the purchase of fire wood, to be accounted for.

Wednesday March 14th 1838.

Certificates of Debt due John N. P. William Murphy for building a new Tobacco Inspection Warehouse in the City of Baltimore were issued as follows viz.
one Certificate for four thousand dollars payable in six months
one Ditto for same " " in twelve months
one Ditto for four thousand eight hundred and eighty eight dollars three cents, payable in eighteen, the whole being interest at the rate of 6% Cent per annum until paid.
