Thursday April 12th 1838.

Treasurer of the Western Shore pay David Ridgely or order
thirty dollars on account of transcribing public documents under Resolution
No 66 of December Session 1835, to be accounted for.

Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Read or order
four dollars and seventy five cents for sweeping chimneys at the Governor's
and State Houses, as per amount proved and allowed.

His Excellency the Governor granted a pardon to Edward Turner
who had been convicted by Baltimore City Court at October term eighteen hun-
dred and thirty six of stealing watches and sentenced to two years confine-
ment in the Penitentiary.

Pennsylvania Institution for the Deaf and Dumb or to his order one thou-
sand one hundred and thirty two dollars and five cents for the education
of Deaf and Dumb indigent children from the State of Maryland.
