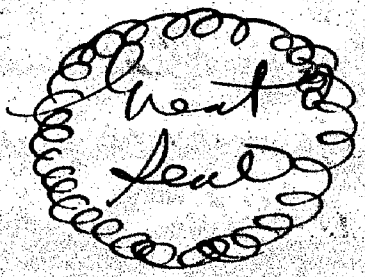

State of Maryland To wit:

Whereas an Election was held on the 25th Instant in the fourth Congressional District of this State; of a member of Congress to supply the vacancy in the representation of that District in the Congress of the United States occasioned by the death of the Hon Isaac McKim;

And whereas it is made the duty of the Governor and Council, after having ascertained the result of said election, to transmit a certificate thereof under the seal of the State to the Secretary of State of the United States, to be by him delivered to the House of Representatives in the Congress of the United States when first assembled thereafter; Now therefore I, Thomas W Veazey Governor of the State of Maryland do hereby Certify, that, by the returns of said Election made conformably to Law it appears that John P Kennedy has been duly elected to supply the aforesaid vacancy in the representation of this State in the Congress of the United States.
