Ordered, that the Adjutant General distribute among the officers of the several Corps of Maryland and the Department of Exercise and Instruction of Field Artillery and published by the Department of War under the authority of an act of Congress of the 2nd of March 1829.

Ordered, that the Adjutant General proceed to the City of Washington and close from the Ordnance Department the amount of the State of Maryland, with the General Government, for its quota of arms due up to the 31st of December 1837 under the act of Congress of 1808.
