Wednesday August 29 1838.

Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to S. J. Felt or order five thousand dollars on account of surveying a route with the view of ascertaining its practicability, from the Chesapeake & Ohio Canal to Baltimore, by the valleys of the Monocacy and C&P, authorized and required by Resolution of December Session 1837, to be accounted for.

By Order of the Governor.

Ordered that the Adjutant General furnish, upon the requisition of General & the Col. Williams twenty Camp Kettles, forty Mops, four Wall Tents, twenty common Batts, one hundred and twenty Knapsacks, one hundred and twenty canteens, one thousand Rifle Flints, one thousand musket Flints, sixty sippers and fifty flasks and pouches: also that he purchase for the use of the same five thousand Pistol Flints.

The Senate not being in Session, His Excellency the Governor appointed Samuel Carlton 2d Lieut of Captain's Company in the 5th Regiment of the Militia of this State in said County.

Thursday August 30 1838.

Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Charles Cook or order nine hundred and eighty five dollars for their services and expenses incurred in going from Baltimore and bringing from thence William Brownell deemed as a fugitive from the Justice of this State of amount authorized.
