May 22nd

May 24th

Fredrick Rodwald having produced to the Governor the President's Executive recognition of him as Consul for the Republic of Hamburg at Baltimore it was ordered to be published for the information and government of the people in the following words.

The State of Maryland

To all whom it may concern

Fredrick Rodwald having produced to me an Executive decree by the President of the United States, and sealed with the Seal of the said State recognizing him as Consul for the Republic of Hamburg at the Port of Baltimore in this State it is ordered that the said recognition be published for the information and government of the people of this State

Given under my hand and the Great Seal of the said State this twenty fourth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine and of the Independence of the United States the sixth day

John Blake and Samuel Freytag who had been arrested in Washington County Court for non-payment of money levies on the Sabbath day, petitioned for the remission of the fine imposed

The petition accompanied with transcripts from the record stated that the law under which they were indicted had not been enforced until they were presented & that it had been used in that County to all before on that day under the ordinary licenses. These cases appearing to be embraced by that of the people the fine was remitted on payment of costs
