

Arrest of a fugitive
And made a demand upon the Governor of New York for Matthias Bloomer and John Brown as fugitives from the justice of this State both being charged with Larceny the first in the City of Baltimore and the other in Cecil County

August 6th

Approval of a board
The Governor approved of the bond of George Mackubin as Treasurer of the Western Shore

August 10th

Remission of a fine
John Case of Alleghany County petitioned for the remission of a fine imposed upon him by John M. Carleton a Justice of the Peace for swearing in his presence. The petition stated that that he was a good citizen and not an habitual drunkard and that when intoxicated he did not know what he was doing. The remission was recommended by John M. Carleton and several respectable Citizens and was granted accordingly on condition of paying the costs.

Arrest de Camp
The Governor appointed George W. Hughes his Aid de Camp, who was accordingly on the same day commissioned

August 11th

Remission of a fine
Euphemia Hanson petitioned for the remission of a fine imposed upon her by Norriston County Court for selling without licence. The petition stated that she had been selling in a small way for a number of years without being aware that she was violating any law and without being molested by any person until that she had been suddenly indicted and fined ten dollars which with the costs amounted to as much as she ever had for sale at any one time. The fine was accordingly remitted.

August 12th

Remission of a Recognizance
Joseph Rowe petitioned for the remission of a recognizance into which he had entered for the appearance of William Cummings before Baltimore City Court

The petition stated that after said recognizance the said Cummings went to Philadelphia and was demanded by the Governor as a fugitive from justice but that on account of some delay he was enabled to make his escape before the requisition could be complied with. That the mother and sister of the said Cummings would be the locus of the recognizance were enforced and asked for their remission on the condition of paying all the costs of the Court and the charges which the State had been put in making said demand. The petition was recommended by the Court and the recognizance was accordingly granted on the condition named in the petition and the recommendations of the Court.
