The Governor pardoned on the recommendation of the Directors of the Penitentiary William Rankin, William

The Governor demanded of the Governor of Pennsylvania as fugitives from the justice of this
State, William Hutchins and Peter Rawlings in the following words:

State of Maryland to wit: William Groom Governor of the State of Maryland
to His Excellency the Governor of Pennsylvania

It appears by the annexed papers duly authenticated according to the laws of this State
that William Hutchins and Peter Rawlings, the former convicted of felony and the latter under
commitment for the same crime broke the jail of Baltimore County in this State on the ninth
day of July last and made their escape therefrom and it has been represented to me that
they have fled from the justice of this State and have taken refuge within the State of Pennsylv-
ania

Now therefore pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and laws of the United
States in such case made and provided, I do hereby request that the said William Hutchins
and Peter Rawlings be apprehended and delivered to John Mitchell who is hereby duly author-
ized to receive and convey them to the State of Maryland there to be dealt with according
to law
