The Governor appointed Francis Edelen, one of the Justices of the 5th Election District Court of Prince Georges County.

The Governor appointed Levin, D. Collier, Chief Justice of the first election District Court of Somerset County, in the place of George Todd, resigned.

The Governor made a demand on the Hon. the Chief Justice of the Circuit Court of the District of Columbia for Alfred Bellows, charged with having committed a felony in the following words: - State of Maryland, to wit: -

It appears by the annexed papers duly authenticated according to the laws of this State, that Alfred Bellows stands charged by the grand Jury of Montgomery County, Maryland, with having committed a felony within the State of Maryland, and it has been represented to me, that he has fled from the Justice of this State, and has taken refuge within the District of Columbia.

Now therefore, pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and laws of the United States in such case made and provided, I do hereby request that the said Alfred Bellows be apprehended and delivered to Henry Lilly, who is hereby duly authorized to receive and convey him to the State of Maryland, there to be dealt with according to law.

In witness whereof, I have hereunto affixed my name, and the great seal of the State this thirty first day of October in the year of our Lord, One thousand eight hundred & forty.
