


The Governor made a demand on the Governor of Pennsylvania for John W. Williams, (alias) Lucky Wood, charged with felony as follows.

State of Maryland to wit.

William Grason Governor of the State of Maryland  
To His Excellency the Governor of Pennsylvania.

It appears by the annexed papers duly authenticated according to the laws of this State, that John W. Williams otherwise called Lucky Wood, stands charged by the presentment of the grand Jury of the State of Maryland, for the body of the City of Baltimore, with feloniously stealing taking and leading away one man of the value of one hundred dollars the property of one John Beard; and it has been represented to me, that he has fled from the justice of this State, and has taken refuge within the State of Pennsylvania.

Now therefore pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution & laws of the United States in such case made and provided, I do hereby request, that the said John W. Williams alias Lucky Wood be apprehended & delivered to Nicholas Tracy who is hereby duly authorized to receive and convey him to the State of Maryland, there to be dealt with according to law.
