

July 15. 1858. The Governor issued a pardon to George Otto convicted in the Circuit Court for Carroll County at the September Term 1856 of Burglary and sentenced to imprisonment in the Penitentiary for five years from 13 Sept. 1856. The pardon was sent to the Warden and a certificate to the Clerk of Carroll C. C. C. Same day. The Governor ordered an advertisement in the Baltimore Clippes of the application for Wol Pro in the case of Joseph Lee convicted at the May Term of the Criminal Court of Baltimore City of an assault with intent to kill a certain William A. Turley, to be taken up 5th August.

July 16th 1858. The Governor issued a pardon to Abraham Ride convicted in the Circuit Court for Howard County at the September Term 1857 of Conspiracy and Attempt to procure abortion on Mary F. Fuller jointly with Dr. Bode and sentenced to confinement in the Baltimore County Jail, and to pay a fine of One Thousand Dollars.

Same day the Governor remitted the fine of one thousand dollars imposed upon Abraham Ride by the Circuit Court for Howard County September Term 1857 for conspiring and attempting to procure an abortion on Mary F. Fuller jointly with Dr. Bode.

August 3rd 1858. The Governor this day issued a Commission to Robert Goldborough (dated 3rd Aug. 1858) appointed by the Orphans' Court of Queen Anne's County as Regent of Wills to fill the vacancy occasioned by the death of Samuel Becker.

August 5th 1858. The Governor this day granted a Nolle Prosequi to Joseph Lee indicted in the Criminal Court for Baltimore City at its May Term Eighteen Hundred and fifty eight for an assault with intent to kill Wm. Alfred Turley by shooting him with a Musket.

August 25th 1858. The Governor issued his Requisition to the Governor of Delaware for the delivery to Barclay Reynolds Sheriff of Cecil County of John and Samuel Wright charged upon affidavits with Larceny.
