The Governor made a demand on the Governor of Pennsylvania in the following words.
States of Maryland. - To wit.

Fugitive.

William Mason Governor of the state of Maryland,
To His Excellency the Governor of Pennsylvania.

It appears by the annexed papers, duly authenticated, according to the laws of this state, that Alfred Procter, a mulatto boy stands charged by the oaths of Matthew James, and Lawrence M. Strong of Felony; and it has been represented to me, that he has fled from the justice of this state, and has taken refuge within the state of Pennsylvania.

Now therefore pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and laws of the United States in such case made and provided, I do hereby request, that the said Alfred Procter be apprehended and delivered to Matthew James Junr, who is hereby duly authorized to receive and convey him to the state of Maryland, there to be dealt with according to law.

The Governor surrendered Christian Warren aka Warner, a fugitive from justice, on the requisition of the Governor of Pennsylvania, to James Young High Constable of the City of Philadelphia, appointed to take charge of him, charged with having stolen goods to the value of three hundred dollars or more, from the store of Isaac Epstein of Philadelphia, upon the oath of said Young. (The warrant for his surrender was directed to the wardens of Washington County Jail, where Warren was confining.)
