

made for Montgomery, Calvert, Harford, and Baltimore Counties on the 16<sup>th</sup> February ult., on the nominations for Directors in the Chesapeake Steam Towing company, on the 3<sup>rd</sup> ult.; for judge of the Land Office for the Eastern shore on the 22<sup>nd</sup> Jan. last, for civil appointments for Montgomery, Baltimore and Allegany Counties on the 25<sup>th</sup> ult.; for Inspector of Lumber at Heckart Town in Cecil County on the 25<sup>th</sup> January last; on the nominations for military appointments made on the 19<sup>th</sup> February; on the nominations for civil appointments for Somerset County, made on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of February, for commissioners to take the acknowledgments of deeds &c.; made on the 8<sup>th</sup> February; for civil appointments for Saint Mary's County, made on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of January, and 9<sup>th</sup> February, for Surveyor of Prince George's county on the 28<sup>th</sup> January, on the military nominations made on the 9<sup>th</sup> of March, and on the nominations for civil appointments for Cecil county made on the 9<sup>th</sup> March.

The Governor issues the following Proclamation.

Proclamation

Whereas by an Act of Assembly of this State, passed at December Session 1832, it is provided, that if a special or Extra Session of Congress should be called to commence at such period as to make it necessary, in the opinion of the Governor and Council, that the Representatives in Congress from this State should be chosen before the time fixed by law for such election, then it shall be the duty of the Governor, by proclamation, to appoint a day for the election of said Representatives in Congress; and whereas the President of the United States has, by his proclamation of the 17<sup>th</sup> ult., an official copy of which has been received, convened the two Houses of Congress to meet on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May next. I do therefore appoint Monday, the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May next as the day for the election of Representatives from this State to serve in the Congress of the United States.

Given under my hand, and the great seal of the State of Maryland, this 26<sup>th</sup> day of March, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty one.
