The Governor issued a Death Warrant for the execution of Frederick Fritz, convicted of Murder in the first degree by Carroll County Court at April Term 1841. to be executed the seventh of (May), on or before 12 O'Clock (M) - see Record of Pardons.

The Governor granted a pardon to Susan Carroll a negro slave the property of Elizabeth Lemon convicted of running away, by Baltimore County Court at April Term 1841. - see Record of Pardons.

The Governor surrendered William Thompson, a fugitive from Justice charged with having committed robbery in Franklin County in the State of Pennsylvania, to George Hoffman, on the demand of the Governor of said State - by an order to the Sheriff of Carroll County.

The Governor granted a Respite to Frederick Fritz, under sentence of death in Carroll County, in consequence of an Application from Isaac Van Bibber, until Friday the fourth day of June next. see Record of Pardons.

Fugitive

The Governor surrendered Thomas M Walker a fugitive from Justice charged with the crime of Burglary, on the demand of the Governor of New York to Benjamin F Days, by an order to the Sheriff of Baltimore County to apprehend and deliver him.

The Governor appointed Robert J. Semmison to serve as the third Justice of the District Court of the first election District of Carroll County in the place of John Jones who declines serving.

The Governor appointed John Conard Justice of the peace for Cecil County in place of Nathan Sackland resigned.
