Refusal The Governor refused to make a demand upon the Governor of Pennsylvania to demand for the runaway slaves of Mr Charles D. Warfield, and Mr Nathan Shipley indicted runaway in Howard District Court, for the reasons set forth in the letter recorded in the Letter Book, addressed to Col. Boyle.

11th

Remission The Governor remitted the recognizances in four several cases forfeited by Robt. of fugitive Davis in St. Mary's County Court on the recommendation of the Hon. Chas. Busby recognizances E. Key.

13th

The Governor made a demand upon the Governor of Pennsylvania as follows.

Demand of fugitives

It appears by the annexed papers duly authenticated according to the laws of this State that mysons, Harry, Pippin, Jonas, Poll, Ruth (child), Lydia, Jake, John and Eliza stand charged by affidavit of felony: and it has been represented to me that they have fled from the justice of this State and have taken refuge within the State of Pennsylvania.

Now therefore, Pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and Laws of the United States in such case made and provided I do hereby request that the said Harry, Pippin, Jonas, Poll, Ruth (child), Lydia, Jake, John and Eliza, be apprehended and delivered to Archibald G. Ridgely who is hereby duly authorized to receive and convey them to the State of Maryland there to be dealt with according to law.
