The Governor sent the following communication to the Senate.

State Department January 1<sup>st</sup> 1842

To the House of Delegates.

In compliance with your order of the 30<sup>th</sup> ultimo, I send herewith Mr Hughes' account for printing the Journal and documents of last session, and also a statement showing how many copies of each ought to have been furnished to the clerks of the different counties, and how many were received. - This statement was prepared by the Secretary of State soon after the Laws and Journals were distributed for the purpose of ascertaining any deficiency in the number of copies. The account was made out by me in the presence of Mr Hughes and was substituted for his original account, which contained various items having no reference to the public printing. The account and statement are the only papers in this Department which have any relation to the contract or duties of Mr Hughes as printer to the last House of Delegates.
