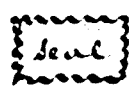


Maryland this eleventh day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two.

Henry Hobbs Act, Secretary of State

To be published in the Republican and Sun, Baltimore, Cambridge Chronicle Cambridge, and Somerset-Herald, Princess Anne, once in each of four successive weeks.

January 14th 1842.

The Governor nominated to the Senate George E Weaver as a Justice of the District of the sixth Election District of Carroll County vice Morelock, who has refused to serve - confirmed on the same day and Commission issued.

The Governor issued a Warrant for the delivery of John Shaw, Arrister Barrow and Thomas Ryland, now confined in Baltimore County Jail, upon a charge of robbing and attempting ^{to fire} the clothing store of George E Smith of Philadelphia, and demanded as fugitives from Justice, by his Excellency the Governor of Pennsylvania to James Young the Agent appointed to receive him.

January 15th

The Governor appointed Benjamin L Howard and Albert Constable Esqs Counsel to assist the Law Officer of the State in the argument of the appeal cases taken from the decisions of the Appeal Tax Court of the City of Baltimore.

January 18th

The Governor made a demand on his Excellency the Governor of New York for Frederick A Weed and William H Weed fugitives from justice, from this State, charged and indicted with fraudulently, embezzling, secreting and making way with money and notes to a large amount, the property of the Commercial Bank of Millington in Kent County to be delivered to Osborn M McDaniel who was appointed Agent to receive him.

The Governor pardoned Hugh McAlamara who was convicted on Indictment in Baltimore City Court at October Term 1840 of assaulting, beating and stabbing Doctor John Whitaker and sentenced to pay a fine of \$300 and costs and imprisoned for the term of two years recommended by the Judges of Baltimore City Court. January 19th

The Governor made a demand on the Honorable William Branch Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of the United States for James F Johnston who stands charged by the affidavit of George W McElroy with committing forgery, and having stolen a mare the property of George Sheppard of the City of Baltimore. - to be delivered to George W McElroy who was appointed Agent to receive him.

January 21st

The Governor nominated to the Senate Jonathan Huddleston as Superintendent of the United States Road within the limits of Maryland vice Thistle - approved by the ^{11th 25th} and Commission issued the 27th instant.

January 22

The Governor nominated to the Senate, James Frost as Surveyor of Howard District in Anne Arundel County.
