

Governor that the Senate advise and consent to the appointment of Civil Officers for Allegany County, agreeably to the list of nominations submitted in the Governor's communication of the 2nd Feb, except Archibald McEl, John Jones, John Black, Murray Mayes, John Daniels, and Thornton L. Moore, to be Justices of the Peace.

This day directed the Adj. General to deliver to Capt David Swan, fifty new muskets, with cartridge boxes, bayonets and scabbards to match. Captain Swan commands the Washington Light Infantry, an uniform company attached to the 36th Regiment of M^o. Ma.

The Governor granted to Ann Sullivan charged with stealing small notes, the property of Reuben Collins, on the latter's and other recommendations a non prosequi: in these words:

"State of Maryland, to wit,

Whereas, a certain Ann Sullivan, late of Baltimore City, has been arrested on the charge of Reuben Collins with having stolen from the said Reuben Collins, small notes of different institutions of the city of Baltimore: And whereas the said Ann Sullivan has been recommended to Executive clemency by the said Reuben Collins and others on the ground that the act of the said Ann Sullivan is not such as can receive a conviction of the said Ann, the said notes according to the laws of this State not being the subject of felony, and because the trial of the case would be productive of nothing other than the exposure of a vice on the part of the said Ann not punishable by the laws of the State, and the mortification of the friends of the said Reuben Collins.

Now therefore I, Francis Thomas, Governor of the State of Maryland, do hereby grant a non prosequi to the said Ann Sullivan on account of the aforesaid offence, upon payment of the costs accrued upon said arrest and other proceedings, if any, and order and direct that all further proceedings against her on the charge aforesaid, do cease and determine, upon payment of the costs for or on account of said offence.
