Whereas, a certain Terence Boyle was convicted on indictment in Anne Arundel County Court at January term, in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty five of Murder in the second degree and sentenced to confinement in the Penitentiary for eighteen years: And whereas, the said Terence Boyle has been recommended to the clemency of the Governor by the Chaplain and Directors of the Penitentiary and others as a pious and reformed man,

Now therefore, I, Francis Thomas, Governor of Maryland, have thought proper to pardon the said Terence Boyle and I do hereby direct that he be immediately released from imprisonment on account of said offence, and grant him a pardon therefor.
