June 25th 1842

This day transmitted to the Governors of the several states and territories, 3 copies of the laws of Maryland of December session 1841, - 1 copy of the journals of Senate & House of Delegates, 1 copy of 10th Volume of Bills & Johnson's Reports; transmitted also to Congressional Librarian copies of the same.

June 28th 1842

This day made a requisition upon the Governor of Pennsylvania for the surrender of Basil Brownfield in the following words:

State of Maryland, - To wit,
Francis Thomas, Governor of Maryland,
To His Excellency the Governor of Pennsylvania.

It appears by the annexed Papers, duly authenticated according to the laws of this state, that Basil Brownfield is charged with the offence of having concealed and supported in Allegany County, Maryland, (knowing him to be a slave) a runaway slave, the property of a certain Thomas Bryson, of Hardy County, Virginia, contrary to the laws of Maryland; and it has been represented to me that he has fled from the justice of this state, and has taken refuge within the state of Pennsylvania.

Now therefore, Pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and laws of the United States in such case made and provided, I do hereby request that the said Basil Brownfield to be apprehended and delivered to _____ who is hereby duly authorized to receive and convey him to the state of Maryland there to be dealt with according to law.

In witness whereof, I have hereunto affixed my name and the Great Seal of the state, this twenty eighth day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty two.
