

custody; the offence with which he is charged being an indictable offence according to the laws of Maryland; and it has been represented to me that he has fled from the justice of this State, and has taken refuge within the State of Pennsylvania

Now Therefore, Pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and laws of the United States in such case made and provided, I do hereby request that the said Thomas Coates to be apprehended and delivered to Mr. George Hughes of Lancaster, Pennsylvania who is hereby duly authorized to receive and convey him to the State of Maryland to be dealt with according to law.

In Witness Whereof, I have hereunto affixed my name and the Great Seal of the State, this seventh day of September in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred and forty two.

This day directed the Sheriff of Baltimore County to deliver to George Moore, a certain James Woods charged upon oath before Richard Ward Esq. Recorder of the City of Philadelphia, with Larceny, said George Moore being the agent appointed by the requisition of the Governor of Pennsylvania to receive said James Woods

Sept 12th 1842

This day made a requisition upon the Governor of New York for Schadrick Bugee Negro, and Elizabeth and Rebecca Negresses; said requisition being in these words:

"State of Maryland, - To Wit:

J. Francis Thomas Governor of Maryland

To His Excellency The Governor of New York

It appears by the annexed Papers, duly authenticated according to the laws of this State, that a Negro Schadrick Bugee, and a Negress Rebecca and Elizabeth did feloniously steal, take and carry away, one black gelding of the value of forty dollars, and that they did wilfully, maliciously and feloniously abduct from the service and custody of John O. Wharton two children named Louis and John, they being Negro slaves of said Wharton, and also two other Negro children named Ellen and Ambrose, slaves and the property of the estate of John Thompson deceased of Maryland, which said acts are indictable offences in the State of Maryland, and it has been represented to me that they have fled from the justice of this State, and have taken refuge within the State of New York

Now Therefore, Pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and laws of the United States in such case made and provided, I hereby request that the said Negro Schadrick Bugee and Negresses Rebecca and Elizabeth to be apprehended and delivered to Archibald G. Ridgely who is hereby authorized to receive and convey them to the State of Maryland to be dealt with according to law.
