

do hereby grant a Nolle Prosequi to the said John C. Towrode on account of the
aforesaid offences, upon payment of the costs accrued upon said proceeding
against him, and order and direct that all further proceedings against him
on the offences aforesaid, do cease and determine, upon payment of the
costs aforesaid, and that no further prosecution be had or carried on
against him for or on account of said offences; provided nevertheless,
and this Nolle Prosequi is granted upon this condition, that the said John C.
Towrode, within the period of thirty days from the date hereof, leave the United
States, and never again return to any one of them.

This day directed the Sheriff of Baltimore County, to apprehend and surrender
to Erasmus Clapp, agent of the State of Massachusetts, James Jones
and George Matten, fugitives from the justice of the State of Massachusetts,
the Governor of that State having made a requisition for them

Nov 27th 1842

This day issued a requisition to the Governor of Virginia for the appre-
-hension and delivery of Isaac Goudkop charged with having ~~obtained~~
goods under false pretences with the design to cheat or defraud, said
requisition being in these words:

"State of Maryland, To wit:

I, Francis Thomas, Governor of Maryland,

To His Excellency The Governor of Virginia

It appears by the annexed Papers, duly authenticated accor-
-ding to the laws of this State, that a certain Isaac Goudkop stands charged
upon oath by E. Miller, of the firm of E. Miller & Co of Baltimore City of
having obtained from E. Miller & Co certain valuable merchandize, under
false pretences with intent to cheat or defraud the said E. Miller & Co, and
the said Isaac Goudkop is also charged upon oath of Franklin Gardner of
the City of Baltimore of having obtained from the said Franklin Gardner,
certain valuable chattels, under false pretences with intent to cheat or de-
-fraud the said Franklin Gardner; and the said Isaac Goudkop is also charged
upon the oath of George T. Mays of the firm of G. T. Mays & Co of the City of
Baltimore of having obtained from the said G. T. Mays & Co certain
valuable chattels under false pretences with intent to cheat or defraud
the said G. T. Mays & Co; and it has been represented to me that
he has fled from the jurisdiction of this State, and has taken refuge
