

June 12th 1843.

This day the Governor remitted the forfeited recognizance entered into by Arthur P. West of Prince George County, on the 27th day of June 1840 for the appearance of Thomas Simpson to answer for a breach of the peace against a certain Paul Talbert; said remission being recommended by the judges of the Court and others.

June 13th 1843.

This day the Governor remitted the forfeited recognizance entered into by Walter W. Brooke, James W. Taylor and Frederick G. Skinner that the said Brooke would appear at October term 1842 of Prince George County to answer unto the State of Maryland in a recognizance to keep the peace upon the information of a certain Newton Littlefield of said County, said remission being recommended by the judges of the Court.

June 12th 1843.

This day the Governor remitted the forfeited recognizance entered into by Arthur P. West of Prince George County for the appearance of a certain John A. Goldborough at the next October term of the County Court of Prince George's County, and that he would keep the peace against a certain Paul Talbert, the said remission being recommended by the judges of the County Court.

June 12th 1843

This day the Governor remitted a fine of \$10 imposed upon John Finnegan by Esquire Grosbeck for violating the act of 1840 respecting Narcotens and Pedlars.

June 12th 1843

The Governor this day, on the recommendation of the Directors of the Maryland Penitentiary, and of a large number of Citizens, pardoned Richard Poole. (see Record of Pardons)

June 14th 1843.

The Governor to day issued a requisition in the following words:

"State of Maryland, - To His Excellency,

J. Francis Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland,

To His Excellency the Governor of New York,

It appears by the annexed Papers, duly authenticated according to the laws of this State, that a certain Nicholas Howard, and a certain Lloyd Howard, mulatto men, did on the twenty fifth day of December in the year Eighteen Hundred and thirty nine, feloniously steal, take and carry away from a certain Richard Dorsey, one cloth coat of the value of fifteen dollars; one pair of pantaloons of the value of three dollars; one great coat of the value of fifteen dollars, and one silver watch of the value of five dollars; which said taking and carrying away is a felony according to the laws of Maryland; and it has been represented to me that they have fled from the justice of this State, and have taken refuge within the State of New York.

And therefore, Pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and laws of the United States in such case made and provided, I do hereby request that the said Nicholas Howard, and Lloyd Howard to be apprehended and delivered to James S. Shelton who is hereby duly authorized to receive and convey them to the State of Maryland, there to be dealt with according to Law.
