

July 7<sup>th</sup> 1843

This day the Governor remitted a fine of ten dollars which was imposed upon John A. Bell,  
by Esquire Eugene Gossel, of Baltimore City, for a violation of the act of 1840 relating to  
Hawks and Pheasants.

July 15<sup>th</sup> 1843

This day the Governor issued a requisition upon the Governor of Pennsylvania for the apprehen-  
sion and surrender of Archibald Smith, said requisition being to these words:

"State of Maryland, - To Nat:

Francis Thomas, Governor of the State of Maryland  
To His Excellency the Governor of Pennsylvania

It appears by the annexed Papers, duly authenticated according to the laws of  
this state, that a certain Archibald Smith, negro, is charged upon the oaths of Richard Emory  
and Jesse Janett, that he the said Archibald Smith did entice, persuade and assist  
certain slaves belonging to these deponents to run off from the deponents service, which said  
act of the said Archibald Smith was a crime according to the laws of Maryland, and  
by some punishable as such; and it has been represented to me that he has fled from the juris-  
diction of this state, and has taken refuge within the state of Pennsylvania.

Now therefore, Pursuant to the provisions of the constitution and laws of the  
United States in such case made and provided, I do hereby request that the said ~~Archibald~~  
Smith, negro, to be apprehended and delivered to Archibald Ridgely of Baltimore  
City, who is hereby duly authorized to receive and convey him to the state of Maryland,  
there to be dealt with according to law.

In witness whereof, I have hereunto affixed my name and the Great  
Seal of the state, this fifteenth day of July in the year of our Lord  
One Thousand Eight hundred and forty three.

July 18<sup>th</sup> 1843

This day the Governor directed an order to be issued for the admission of James Con-  
nell of Montgomery County into the institution for the instruction of the blind, as a pupil  
of Maryland.

July 21<sup>st</sup> 1843

This day the Governor remitted one half of the fine (two hundred & fifty dollars) of five hundred dol-  
lars which was imposed upon Robert Ramsey by Anne Arundel County Court, at April term, eighteen  
hundred & forty two for keeping a Fas-table, he having served out in jail his full time, and  
been strongly recommended to Executive clemency.

July 21<sup>st</sup> 1843

The Governor, this day remitted one half of the fine which was imposed upon Francis A. Steers  
by Anne Arundel County Court at October term eighteen hundred and forty three for  
an assault and battery upon one Abram Green, the said Steers having been con-  
fined in jail for three months.
