This day, the Governor on the recommendation of the judges of Prince George's County Court committed a forfeited recognizance which was entered into by Hanson Littlefield, John Humphrey, and Thomas Baldwin of Prince George's County for the appearance of the said Hanson Littlefield before Prince George's County Court, at October Term 1842, it appearing from the petition of the said Hanson Littlefield, that he did attend said Court, but that on
