This day remitted a fine of ten dollars which was imposed upon William Alley by  
Queen Ann County Court at November 1843 for selling liquor without a license the  
same being recommended by the Judges of said court.

December 7<sup>th</sup> 1843.

This day granted the following Nolle Prosequi.

"State of Maryland, - To Wit:

Whereas Allen Griffith, William Carmichael and Christopher Brown  
late of Baltimore County stand charged by indictment of the Grand Jury of the  
said County with larceny of three live tame ducks, the property of one Francis  
Waltmeyer; and whereas the said persons have been recommended to Execu-  
-tive clemency by the Judges of Baltimore County Court and others,

Now, Therefore, I, Francis Thomas, Governor of the State of Mary-  
-land, do hereby grant a Nolle Prosequi to the said persons on account  
of the aforesaid offence, upon payment of the costs accrued upon said in-  
-dictments, and other proceedings, if any, and order and direct that all fur-  
-ther proceedings against them on the indictments aforesaid, do cease and deter-  
-mine, upon payment of the costs aforesaid, and that no further prosecution be had  
or carried on against them for or on account of said offence.

This day on the recommendation of a large number of the citizens of Allegany  
County, the Governor remitted the fines of twenty, ten, and fifteen dollars  
which were imposed upon James M<sup>o</sup>. Enally by Allegany County Court in three  
different cases, one for an assault and battery, one for selling liquor on a  
Sunday, and the other for a disorderly house. The said M<sup>o</sup>. Enally having been con-  
-fined in jail for a considerable time, and being wholly destitute of the means to  
pay the fines on the reasons for the remission
