Now Therefore, I Francis Thomas, Governor of the State of Maryland do hereby grant a Nolle Prosequi to the said Jason Thompson, on account of the aforesaid offence, upon payment of the costs accrued upon said Indictment, and also upon the further condition that the said Jason Thompson shall leave the State of Maryland, within sixty days, and do shall not return thereto, and order and direct that all further proceedings against him on the indictment aforesaid do cease and determine, upon payment of the costs aforesaid, and that no further prosecution be had or carried on against him for, or on account of, said offence.

This day the Governor granted the following Nolle Prosequi,
State of Maryland, to wit,

Whereas a certain negro Suckey late of Washington County stands charged by Presentment of the Grand Jury of the said County, with running away from her Master George Lefevor; and Whereas the said negro Suckey has been recommended to Executive Clemency by her said Master, and a number of his neighbours who represent that neither the public interests, nor the cause of public justice would be injuriously affected by the exercise of Executive Clemency;

Now Therefore, I Francis Thomas, Governor of the State of Maryland do hereby grant a Nolle Prosequi to the said negro Suckey on account of the aforesaid offence, upon payment of the costs accrued upon said Presentment, and order and direct that all further proceedings against her on the Presentment aforesaid do cease and determine, upon payment of the costs aforesaid, and that no further prosecution be had or carried on against her, for or on account of said offence.
