Now Therefore; these are to authorize you to cause the said Charles Turner Torrey to be apprehended, if he is in your bailiwick, and delivered to Bushrod Taylor, the agent appointed by his Excellency the Governor of Virginia, to receive and convey him to the said State;— the said Agent first paying all the costs and charges of the arrest and detention of the said Charles T. Torrey; his removal not to take place until he has been tried for any offense he may have committed against the Laws of this State.

For all which this shall be your sufficient Warrant and Authority;

Given under my hand and the Great Seal of the State of Maryland, on this first day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty four.

This day the Governor issued the following Requisition, to wit,

State of Maryland, - to wit,

Francis Thomas, Governor of the State of Maryland,

To His Excellency the Governor of Pennsylvania,

It appears by the annexed Papers duly authenticated according to the laws of this State that a certain Leonard Butler, a negro, a citizen of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, committed the crime of Felony, and it has been represented to me that the said Butler has fled from the justice of this State, and has taken refuge within the State of Pennsylvania;

Now Therefore, pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and Laws of the United States in such case made and provided, I do hereby request that the said Leonard Butler be apprehended and delivered to John H. Johnson, who is hereby duly authorized to receive and convey him to the State of Maryland, there to be dealt with according to law.

In Witness whereof I have hereunto affixed my name, and the Great Seal of the State this eighth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty four.
