Montgomery County Court, at November Term 1844, of assault and Battery with
intent to Kill (for Pardon see Record of Pardons)

August 23. 1844

This day the Governor granted a Pardon to William Clark, convicted in
Prince George's County Court at October Term 1837, of stealing (for Pardon see
Record of Pardons).

August 23. 1844.

This day the Governor granted a Pardon to Ida Grimes convicted in Prince
George's County Court at October Term 1837 of stealing. (for Pardon see Record of
Pardons)

August 23. 1844

This day the Governor granted a Pardon to John Williams, alias Long Gordon,
convicted in Baltimore City Court at October Term 1837, of stealing (for Pardon see
Record of Pardons)

August 26. 1844

This day the Governor remitted the fine of fifty dollars imposed by the Court of
Howard District upon Jesse Duval at March Term 1844, for an assault and
Battery on Eli H. Duval; at the recommendation of the Grand and Petit Jurors and
other respectable citizens.

August 26. 1844

This day the Governor remitted the forfeited Recognizance of Owen Straight in St
Marys County, to keep the Peace &c, and especially against Abel Elvey.

September 14. 1844

This day the Governor released the penalty of paying interest, incurred by Lewis Peters owner
- of the Direct Taxes for Carole County for the year 1841.

September 17. 1844

This day the Governor issued the following Solli Prosequi &c.
