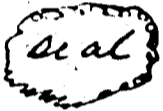

Delivery of Isaac Wamsley -

State of Maryland sets

To his Excellency the Gov. of Virginia

It appears by the annexed papers duly authenticated according to the laws of this State that Isaac Wamsley stands charged, with the crime of obtaining goods on false pretences & it has been represented to me that he has fled from the justice of this State and has taken refuge in the State of Va. Now therefore in pursuance of the Constitution & Laws of the United States in such case made & provided I Thomas G. Pratt Gov. of the State of Maryland do hereby request that the said Isaac Wamsley be apprehended and delivered to John Lamb who is hereby duly authorized to receive & convey him to this State to be dealt with according to Law
