

Feb 20<sup>th</sup> 1845-

Carroll The Gov. This day nominated to the Senate John Mathias as County Notary Public to reside at Westminster in Carroll County.

Ind. House The Gov. This day upon the recommendation of Hon. Tho. B. Doney remission and numerous Citizens of Montgomery County, remitted the fine imposed upon John Hones (in three cases of assault and battery) by the County Court at March Term 1844.

Feb: 24<sup>th</sup> 1845

Warrant for the del. Pennsylvania for the delivery to his Agent of Henry Breunerman charged with the crimes of fornication and Bastardy issued his Warrant for the delivery of the said Henry Breunerman to Jacob Holly the Agent named in said requisition.

Feb: 25<sup>th</sup> 1845

Wm. Triggs The Gov. This day refused to grant a pardon to William Triggs (a Negro man) convicted in Balt. City Court at the February term of said Court 1845, of the crime of Bigamy. This Convict was recommended to the Executive Clemency by the Judges of Balt. City Court but it appearing that the said Negroe had married two white Women within this State, the Gov. thought it would be against the policy of the State to encourage such connections by granting a pardon in such a case.

Kent County. The Gov. this day sent to the Senate the civil list for Kent County.

P.G. Co. Justice District Court The Gov. this day nominated J.W. Hyatt District Justice of Magistrate Court in Prince Geo. County vice S. Hamilton (declined).

Wiley Tucker The Gov. This day refused to grant a Nolle prosequi to Wiley Tucker of Calvert County charged with assaulting Henry Howler with intent to Kill.

A. Warfield The Gov. this day refused to grant a Nolle Prosequi to Abraham Warfield of Frederick County, indicted by Frederick County Court at the October Term 1844 for Kidnapping.

Feb: 26<sup>th</sup> 1845-

Clarke Somerset Co. County The Gov. This day nominated Mr. J. G. Polk as Clerk of Somerset County vice Lewis Hemmely resigned.

P. G. Co. The Gov. This day nominated additional Justices of the Peace for P. G. County.

Feb: 27<sup>th</sup> 1845-

Alleghany County The Gov. This day nominated to the Senate as Notary Public and additional Justices of the Peace for Alleghany County.
