Refused to grant Nolle Prosequi The Gov. this day refused to grant a Nolle Prosequi to Joseph Nyer and Roderick Nyer (Slaves) indicted in Howard District Court for Grand Larceny.

March 6<sup>th</sup> 1845

Refused to grant Pardon The Gov. this day refused to grant a pardon to Elisha Beale of Allegany County convicted before Allegany County Court of the crime of Grand Larceny.

March 6<sup>th</sup> 1845

Refused to grant Nolle Prosequi The Gov. this day refused to grant a Nolle Prosequi to Thomas Malone John Bowles and Elijah Chatham of Somerset County accused of violating the Sabbath.

March 7<sup>th</sup> 1845

Wilson N. Nicholas Commissioner The Gov. this day nominated Wilson N. Nicholas Commissioner on the part of this State to take acknowledgment of deeds &c. in State of Virginia.

R. N. Martin Chief Justice The Gov. this day nominated R. N. Martin to be Chief Judge of the 5<sup>th</sup> District.
