Warrant The Gov. This day upon the requisition of the Gov. of Delaware for the delivery to his Agent of Edward Salisbury Benjamin Delany Hanson charged with the crime of kidnapping issued his warrant for the delivery of the said Edward Salisbury unto Benjamin Hanson to William Canth the Agent named in the said requisition - additional affidavits having been furnished to the Gov. This 23rd July 1845

July 24th 1845

A. Hoffmann The Gov. This day (at the request of the Trustees of the Poor) gave an order for the admission of Oliver Anderson Hoffmann of Bath City into the Penoyevanic Institution for the instruction of indigent blind

July 29th 1845

Collector The Gov. This day (upon the affidavit of P. O'Neill that he had received no interest upon the State tax of Frederick County for the year 1843) released him from the payment of the same

July 31st 1845

The State of Maryland, to the Sheriff of Cecil County, greeting

In pursuance of Law I Tho. G. Pratt

Warrant Gov. of the State of Maryland, do hereby order & direct that an election be held for State Senators for Cecil County on the first Wednesday of October next ensuing (being the first day of the said month) to supply the vacancy in the Senate of Maryland for the said County occasioned by the resignation of George H. Howard, which has been duly communicated to me in writing, and you are hereby commanded to give notice of such election in conformity with the requirements of Law

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & caused the great seal of the State to be affixed This 31st day of July in the year one thousand eight hundred & forty five and of the Independence of the United States the seventeenth

Collector The Gov. This day upon the affidavit of William H. Charles Browner Collector of Charles County that he had received no interest upon the State tax, released him from the payment of the same on the several sums collected by him
