The Gov. This day refused to pardon Abraham Lynch ~~and~~ slave
convicted in Baltimore County Court at November Term 1845 and
sentenced to be whipped for riot

B. Davis The Gov. This day refused to remit a fine imposed upon John
B. Davis of Dorset County imposed upon him by Dorset County
Court for Assault and Battery at April Term 1845. This prayer was
afterwards granted upon the recommendation of the Judge
December 6th 1845

H. Terry The Gov. day granted a pardon to Robert Terry upon the
pardon recommendation of Judge Martin who was convicted in
Allegheny County Court of Assault & Battery, see record of pardons
December 8th 1845

Requisition The Gov. upon the affidavits of George E. Sangston & Lawrence
Sangston issued a requisition upon the Gov. of Ohio for the
delivery of N. E. Loomans who stands charged with the crime
of obtaining goods upon false pretences - John Zell is app-
ointed agent, the parties pay expenses
Dec 9th

Requisition The Gov. This day issued a requisition upon the Governor
upon the Delaware for the delivery of Negroe Saml. Hawkins to
Governor Joel Thomas, the Agent named, who is charged upon the
Delaware affidavit of said Thomas with the crime of enticing away
Slaves from Queen Anne's County
December 10th

Requisition The Gov. This day, in obedience to a requisition from the Governor
from Pennsylvania issued a warrant for the apprehension and
the delivery of Gershom Levi, to James Maginnis the Agent named.
The said Levi stands indicted for the crime of conspiring with
others to cheat his Creditors
Decr. 12th 1845

Requisition upon the Gov. of South Carolina The Governor this day ~~request~~ granted a requisition
upon the Governor of South Carolina for the delivery of Robert Perry charged
on indictment with the crime of Conspiracy to cheat Isaac H. Jones. Expenses
to be paid by the Party asking for the Requisition.

Samuel The Gov. This day, upon the recommendation of Judge Buchanan
Darnell granted a pardon to Samuel Darnell convicted in Washington
County Court at November Term 1845 of Petit Larceny and
sentenced to the Penitentiary, see record of pardons
Decr. 20th 1845

Peter The Gov. refused to grant a pardon to Peter Mathias
Mathias convicted in Balt. City Court at October Term of Assault
pardon with intent to kill Elizabeth Hill - This pardon was after-
wards granted, see record of pardons
