March 10th

The Governor this day approves the official Bond of Truman Belt as Inspector of Tobacco in Baltimore City

March 13th

Request. The Governor this day in obedience to a requisition from the Governor of Pennsylvania issued a warrant for the surrender Thomas Fitzgerald to George Hoffman the Agent named. The said Fitzgerald being charged in indictment in the Court of Oyer & Terminer & Quarter Sessions in & for the City & County of Philadelphia at March Session 1846 of the crime of conspiracy

March 14th

The Governor this day approves the official bond of Jas. G. MacMall as Jail Bond Inspector of Tobacco in the City of Baltimore

The Governor this day approves the official Bond of Tho. Gemmill as High Master Western Hay Scales in the City of Baltimore

The Gov. this day approves the official Bond of H. Kent as High Master of Lane Stock in the City of Baltimore

March 24th

The Gov. this day directs the Adj. General to cause to be removed from the State House to the State Gun House the Tent Poles belonging to the State, their removal being deemed necessary by reason of the contemplated repairs to the State House

States of Maryland

To the Sheriff of Charles County, Greeting: Whereas, William Wheeler, late of Charles County, was convicted in Charles County Court, at the August Term of said Court Anno Domini, eighteen hundred and forty five, of the crime of Insurrection and sentenced by the said Court to be hung by the neck until he was dead. And whereas, by an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at December Session, 1845, entitled an Act to authorize and require the Wardens and Keepers of the Penitentiary of Maryland, to receive and keep Negro William Wheeler, now under sentence of death into the Penitentiary in the event of the commutation of his sentence by the Governor

Now Therefore, I, Tho. G. Pratt, Governor of the State of Maryland, do hereby in virtue of the authority so vested in me by the said Act of Assembly, will and require, and also charge and command you, that you shall upon the receipt of this warrant take the said William Wheeler from your prison and conduct him to the Penitentiary House of this State, to be there confined during the period of his natural life, Provided the said William Wheeler shall assent to said commutation
