

June 11th 1846

Requestion from the Gov of Pennsylvania The Governor this day upon the requisition of the Gov. of Pennsylvania issued a warrant for the apprehension & delivery (to Benjamin Shriver the Agent Gov of named) of Lydia Ann Steller who stands charged and indicted in the Pennsylvania Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace held in and for the County of Adams at April Session 1846 of the Crime of Conspiracy

A. Martin The Governor this day refused to grant a pardon to Richard Martin convicted in Baltimore City Court October Term 1845 of the same offence and sentenced to the Penitentiary

June 3rd 1846

Requestion from the Governor of New York The Governor this day upon the requisition of the Governor of New York issued a warrant for the apprehension and delivery (to Geo Demister the Agent) of Michael McCabe who stands charged and indicted in the Court of General Sessions of the Peace of the City & County of New York with the crime of obtaining goods by false pretences.

June 5th 1846

Thos Burnes The Gov. this day upon the recommendation of the Judges of Balt. City Court & the Jury (who tried him) granted a pardon to Thomas Burnes see record of pardons

W. Baiding The Gov. this day refused to remit a fine imposed upon Ernest M. Baiding for violation of the Licenses Law

June 17th

La Flour The Governor refused to grant a pardon to Horatio Nelson Dudley La Flour at present confined in the Penitentiary

June 19th

Treasurers Bond The Gov. this day approved the official Bond of D. Claude as Treasurer of Maryland

Ann Matthews The Gov. this day refused to grant a pardon to Ann Maria Stevons convicted in Baltimore City Court at May Term 1846 of felony

June 25th

Requestion from the Gov of Massachusetts The Governor this day upon the affidavit of Thos B. Cowley issued a requisition upon the Gov. of Massachusetts for the apprehension and delivery of Henry Washington (to John Mitchell Agent) who stands charged with petit Larceny

June 27th

Caroline Wright The Gov. this day refused a pardon to Caroline Wright convicted in Balt. City Court at May Term 1846 of felony and sentenced to the Penitentiary
