The Governor this issued a requisition upon the Governor of  
Pennsylvania for the apprehension & delivery (to Madison Jeffers Agent)  
of John B. Zimmerman and Thomas Bluetts indicted in Baltimore City  
Court for the crime of obtaining goods upon false pretences &  
the Agent to pay his own expenses

October 20<sup>th</sup> 1846

The Governor this day (in compliance with a requisition from  
the Governor of Pennsylvania) issued a warrant to the Sheriff of  
Alleghany County for the apprehension & delivery of Uriah Cook  
to John Jackson Agent, the said Cook being charged upon the affi-  
davit of William O. Kennedy with the crime of Larceny

Oct 22<sup>nd</sup> 1846

The Governor this day upon the recommendations of the judges  
of Baltimore City Court remitted the forfeited recognizance of  
Richard H. Battee for the appearance of George M. Graham before  
said Court at September Term 1846, on condition of payment of  
costs

State of Maryland, To Wits

Whereas in virtue of a commission duly issued  
on the 2<sup>d</sup> day of July last to Charles M. Howard, Alexander J. Bouldin  
John H. Ehlers Esquires, to examine & report in writing to the Governor  
of Maryland whether the Procs of the Baltimore & Harford Turn-  
pike Company is extended for the distance of five miles progressively  
in addition to the ten miles already licensed in a masterly and  
workmanlike manner agreeably to the Act entitled "an Act for  
making certain Procs in Baltimore & Harford County" And  
Whereas the said Charles M. Howard, Alexander J. Bouldin and  
John Ehlers Esquires, have under their hands & Seals by an instru-  
ment in writing dated the 22<sup>d</sup> day of September last reported  
to me that they have viewed & examined the said Procs for the  
distance of five miles from the ten miles already licensed,  
and that the same for that distance progressively is finished  
and completed in a masterly & workmanlike manner agreeably  
to the provisions of the said Law -

Therefore, I, Thos. G. Pratt, Governor of  
Maryland do hereby license & permit & suffer the President  
and Managers of the said Baltimore & Harford Turnpike  
Company to erect & fit such & so many Gates or Turnpikes  
upon and across the said Procs as will be necessary and  
sufficient to collect the tolls and duties granted by Law  
to the said Company from all persons travelling and
