The Governor this day granted a Nolle Prosequi to James Goldsborough, who was indicted in Talbot County Court for offering a bribe to Millicen Kemp for the purpose of influencing his vote - it being recommended by sundry Citizens of Talbot County -

C. P. Mills

The Governor this day refused to remit the recognizance forfeited by Charles P. Mills of Talbot County for not appearing as a recognizance witness at Talbot County Court. The Governor's refusal in this case is predicated upon his construction of the 1st section of the Act of 1782 Ch. 92 by which he thinks this power can only be exercised where the remission is recommended by the Court -

Pardon

The Governor this day upon the recommendation of the Judges of Dorchester County Court commuted the punishment in the case of Demetrius Camper - see Record of pardons Dec. 27th ..

Requisition

The Governor this day issued a requisition upon the Gov. of Pennsylvania for the apprehension & delivery of (to George Hughes Agent) of Joseph Fox who stands charged with the crime of Larceny - since Agent to act free of cost to the State -
