The Governor this day issued the following requisition to the Governor of the State of New York for the apprehension and delivery up of a certain Frederick Warner a fugitive from justice.

State of Maryland to wit:

Philip Francis Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland
To his Excellency the Governor of New York.

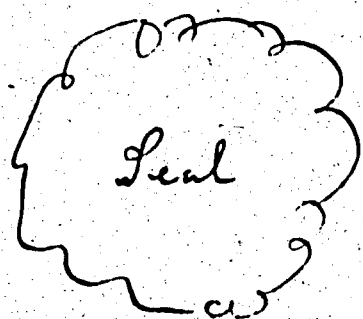
It appears by the annexed papers duly authenticated according to the laws of this State, that a certain Frederick Warner stands charged on the oath of one John Baker with the crime of stealing from the said John Baker or on about the eleventh day of July in the year eighteen hundred and forty eight the sum of forty dollars in silver and gold coin the property of the said John Baker, and it has been represented to me that he has fled from the justice of this State, and has taken refuge within the State of New York.

Now therefore, pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and Laws of the United States in such case made and provided, I do hereby request that the said Frederick Warner be apprehended and delivered to Jacob Cook a citizen of the State of Maryland who is hereby duly authorized to receive and convey him to the State of Maryland, there to be dealt with according to law.

In witness whereof, I herewith affixed my name and the Great Seal of the State this eighteenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty eight.

The Governor also issued the following requisition to the Governor of the State of Pennsylvania for the apprehension and delivery up of Paul Kunkle a fugitive justice of this State.

State of Maryland to wit:

Philip Francis Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland.
To his Excellency the Governor of Pennsylvania.

It appears by the annexed Papers, duly authenticated according to the laws of this State, that a certain Paul Kunkle stands charged on the oaths respectively of Lego Cooper and John B. Kidd with the crime of being an accomplice in the murder of a certain Elizabeth Cooper who was murdered at or near the branch near Parkton in Baltimore County in the said State of Maryland on the 29th day of May last by blows inflicted on her head with some hard substance and it has been represented to me that he has fled from the justice of this State and has taken refuge within the State of Pennsylvania.

Now therefore, pursuant to the Constitution and Laws of the United States in such case made and provided, I do hereby request that the said Paul Kunkle be apprehended and delivered to A. G. Ridgely a citizen of the State of Maryland who is hereby duly authorized to receive and convey him to the State of Maryland there to be dealt with according to law.

In witness whereof, I have herewith affixed
