July 25th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Henry Diggs
Inspector of Lumber in the City of Baltimore vice John W. Davis resigned.

The Governor appointed and commissioned William Lyles Hutton
Associate Justice of the District Court of the 5th District in Prince Georges County vice
Henry D. Hutton resigned. He also appointed and commissioned Walter H. Adam
son a Justice of the Peace in Montgomery County vice Daniel H. Chandler resigned.

July 26th 1848.

The Governor this day granted a Nolle Prosequi to negro John a
slave of David Hoxter late of Talbot County deceased who was charged with the
crime of stealing six bushels of corn the property of John W. D. Goldborough of said
County on condition of the said slave being sold out of the State.

The Governor appointed and commissioned Henry Corkran
Surveyor of Caroline County vice Willis Corkran resigned. He also appointed and
commissioned John Lowe a Justice of the Peace for Montgomery County vice Geo
C. Patterson removed out of the State.

July 27th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Henry C.
Bateman Col vice Hon P. F. Thomas Governor of the State, and Richard Thomas Lt Col
vice Bateman promoted in the 4th Regiment of M. M. He also appointed and
commissioned William Hayward Lt Col vice Haddaway deceased and James H.
Ridgway Major vice Hayward promoted in the 26th Regiment of M. M.
He also appointed and commissioned Isaac Stansbury Col vice Amos resigned
and John W. Rutledge Lt Col vice Stansbury promoted in the 40th Regiment of M. M.
He also appointed and commissioned John Satterfield Captain vice Sherwood
removed. Thomas R. Hephlett 1st Lieut vice Robson resigned and Hall H. Hayward
2nd Lieut vice Graham resigned of the Eastern Guards in the 4th Regiment of M. M.
He also appointed and commissioned Nathaniel W. Comeyes Adjutant vice Hon
resigned in 33rd Regiment M. M. and William Watts 2nd Lieut vice Kelly resigned in
the company commanded by Capt John Gale in 33rd Regiment M. M. He also appointed
and commissioned James C. Worthington Surgeon vice J. C. Worthington resigned and
Joseph F. Keenan Surgeon's-mate vice H. Hunkley removed in the 1st Rifle Regiment of
Maryland Militia.
