

July 31st 1848.

The Governor this day granted a pardon to John Cummins convicted in Howard District Court of an Assault with the intent to kill, it having been represented that the conviction of Cummins was in consequence of a conspiracy among the witnesses who testified against him. He also granted a pardon to Joseph Owens convicted in Anne Arundel County Court of Murder in the second degree.

The Governor remitted the fine of Twenty dollars imposed on John W. Bradley by Caroline County Court at March Term 1848. for an Assault and Battery on Zebadiah W. Potter.

August 1st 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Noble Pennington Associate Justice of the Orphans Court of Cecil County vice Richard J. Ford resigned. He also appointed and commissioned William Poteler Coroner in Prince George County those previously appointed having declined to serve.

The Governor appointed and commissioned James T. Mayre Commissioner for the State of Maryland to take acknowledgment of deeds and instruments of writing under seal, in the State of Mississippi.

August 2nd 1848.

The Governor this day received from the Governor of the State of Pennsylvania a requisition for the apprehension and delivery up of Joseph Johnson a fugitive from justice of that State, and accordingly a warrant was issued for the arrest and delivery of the said fugitive to the Agent of the State of Pennsylvania.

The Governor issued his requisition to the Governor of the State of New York for the apprehension and delivery up of William H. Robinson a fugitive from justice of this State as follows.

State of Maryland, to wit:

Philip Francis Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland.
To his Excellency, the Governor of New York.

It appears by the annexed papers, duly authenticated according to the laws of this State that a certain William H. Robinson of the City of Baltimore, stands charged with having obtained fraudulently and under false pretences, between the twelfth day of June and the thirteenth day of July last past, goods, wares and merchandises of and from Martin Lewis & Co Merchants of said City to the value of three hundred and sixty one dollars and one cent current money and it has been represented to me that he has fled from the justice of this State and has taken refuge within the State of New York.

Now therefore pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and Laws of the United States in such case made and provided, I do hereby request that the said William H. Robinson be apprehended and delivered to William Snyder Agent of the State of Maryland who is hereby duly authorized to receive and convey him to the State of Maryland then to be dealt with according to law.
