

September 7th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Jacob Wilson Lt Col in 11th Regiment M. M. vice Joel Cornell resigned. And Hiram Durenburgh 1st Lieut in Capt Lamas' company in 28th Regiment M. M. and Thomas D. Ham 2nd Lieut in same company.

September 8th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Gilbert Swan Drm Major in 3rd Battalion M. M. Caroline county vice Wiley deceased.

September 9th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned James L Davis 2nd Lieut in Capt George W. Spencer's Troop of Horse in the 8th Regimental Cavalry District M. M. vice Newnam resigned.

The Governor on the recommendation of the Rev William E. May att. D. C. granted a pardon to George M. Stewart a convict in the Penitentiary from Washington county.

The Governor appointed and commissioned Richard H. Bennett Justice of the Peace in St Marys County vice John W. Bennett deceased.

September 14th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Clement Butler Colonel vice Aquila Brown deceased. John C. Walsh Lt. Col. vice Butler promoted and A. L. Jarratt Major vice Walsh promoted in the 7th Regimental Cavalry District Maryland Militia. And also John Manning Captain vice John H. Groomer resigned. James M. Marshall 1st Lieut vice Geo. T. Dowell resigned and George W. Gardiner 2nd Lieut vice Manning promoted in the 17th Regiment M. M.

September 21st 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Charles Hickley 1st Lieut and David F. Beveridge 2nd Lieut of "Maryland Guards" attached to the 53rd Regiment Maryland Volunteer Infantry. And also James D. Ricard Lt Col vice Monte Miller resigned and George Vickers Major vice Ricard promoted in the 21st Regiment M. M.

The Governor appointed and commissioned John Piper Justice of the Peace in Allegany County vice Jasper Robinett declined.

The Governor also appointed and commissioned Peter Bandry Garsche Commissioner to take the acknowledgment of deeds for the State of Maryland, residing at St Louis in the State of Missouri.

September 25th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Francis Boyd Justice of the Peace in Cecil County vice Geo Davidson declined. He also appointed and commissioned William Thompson Palmer Justice of the Peace vice Michael Byrne declined, and William Hanna Associate Justice of District Court in 9th District of Frederick County vice James Hanna the name James being incorrect the individual the same.
