

September 26th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Theodore Mead Colonel vice John Hughes deceased. Henry H. Hawkins Lt Col vice Mead promoted and Robert Digges Major vice Hawkins promoted in the 1st Regiment of M. M.

The Governor also appointed and commissioned Walter Mitchell Lt Col vice W. M. Miller promoted, John B. Lawson Major vice Francis D. Green resigned and William Smith vice John B. Ferris removed from the district in the 43rd Regiment of M. M.

The Governor also appointed and commissioned Isaac Griffiths Captain of the "Baltimore County Blues" of the 1st Independent Volunteer Regiment M. M. in Baltimore County.

October 2nd 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Levi Lamotte Justice of the Peace in Baltimore County vice Lewis Dahoff deceased. He also appointed and commissioned James L. Cory Justice of the Peace in Charles County vice James E. Keech resigned.

October 3rd 1848.

The Governor this day on the recommendations of the Judges of Kent County Court remitted the fine of Ten dollars imposed by the said Court on John C. Boshell for selling liquor without license.

October 4th 1848.

The Governor this day on the recommendation of one of the Judges of Baltimore City Court remitted the fine of Fifty dollars imposed by the said Court at September Term 1848, on Thomas Fidler for selling goods without license.

October 5th 1848.

The Governor this appointed and commissioned M. Curran Harney Captain, Walter McKier 1st Lieut and Augustus Gapaway 2nd Lieut of the "Annapolis Guards" a Rifle Corps attached to 22nd Regiment M. M.

October 9th 1848.

The Governor having received the returns of the elections held on the 4th inst in City of Baltimore and the several counties, the said returns being duly certified to by the return judges of said election, this day commissioned as Sheriff Charles F. Cloud for Baltimore City, Joshua A. Hynes for Baltimore County, William Doyen for Anne Arundel County, Norman D. Harding for Frederick County, John B. Robertson for Charles County, John Barnard for Allegany County, Francis Carr for Kent County, Hanson S. Webb for Carroll County, William Hanes for Cecil County, Robert McGaw for Harford County, Daniel Souths for Washington County, William W. Lowe for Talbot County, Edward L. L. Young for Caroline County, James S. Chew for Prince Georges County and John Richardson for Dorchester County.
