

January 10<sup>th</sup> 1849.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Fadden Suit Coroner in Prince Georges County vice Boteler declined.

The Governor on the recommendation of the Grand Jury and numerous other respectable citizens of Washington County granted a Nolle Prosequi to David Howard of said County, who stands charged with Felony.

January 11<sup>th</sup> 1849.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned George P. Kane Lt Col of 2<sup>nd</sup> Regiment of Artillery in Baltimore City to take rank from the 29<sup>th</sup> of May 1846, and also C. B. Phillips 1<sup>st</sup> Lieut, John T. Farlow 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieut and Isaac Wagner 3<sup>rd</sup> Lieut of the "Eagle Artillery" attached to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Regiment of Artillery of Baltimore City 3<sup>rd</sup> Division M. M.

January 12<sup>th</sup> 1849.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Edward Dubois Justice of the Peace in Anne Arundel County vice Allen Welch who has failed to qualify.

The Governor issued an order for the admission of Terrence Marrow a deaf mute into the Pennsylvania Institution for the Instruction of the Deaf and Dumb as a pupil of the State of Maryland.

The Governor appointed and commissioned John D. Corbin and Jacob A. J. Townsend Justices of the District Court of the 7<sup>th</sup> District in Worcester County vice Dryden and Tuley declined.

January 15<sup>th</sup> 1849.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Thomas A. Edgell Justice of the Peace in Talbot County vice Jesse Scott resigned. He also appointed and commissioned Zacheariah H. Worthington, William H. Waters, Hazel Hobbs and Joseph Loper Justices of the Peace in Montgomery County vice Lloyd Dorsey, George T. Pope, Kimrod Davis and Edward T. Owen declined.

The Governor rejected the application of George H. Hammer of Washington County for a Nolle Prosequi.

The Governor appointed and commissioned Thomas Forey Justice of the Peace in Charles County vice Edmund Perry resigned.

The Governor appointed and commissioned Fowles L. Green Commissioner to take the acknowledgement of Deeds, residing in Herkimer County New York.
