

January 17th 1849.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Matthew Howlet Coroner in Harford County vice Thomas Pater declined. And also Horatio N. Harne Justice of the Peace in Washington County vice Jno B. Costambader resigned.

January 18th 1849.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Jacob Thowen Clerk of Carroll County Court, his term of office having this day expired.

The Governor appointed and commissioned Thomas M. Bacon Justice of the District Court of the 6th District in Harford County vice W. D. Morgan declined.

The Governor refused the application of William Birch for a pardon as also the application of Richard J. Turner for a pardon.

January 19th 1849.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Thomas D. Murray Armorer at Frederick City vice Everts deceased. And also George Strailman Justice of the Peace in Frederick County vice George Hauer deceased.

January 20th 1849.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Granville S. Oldfield Jr Commissioner of Deeds to reside at San Francisco, California.

The Governor appointed and commissioned David Archibald Justice of the Peace in Cecil County vice Francis Boyd declined.

January 23rd 1849.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Jeremiah Melikin Jr Justice of the Peace in Prince George's County vice John H. Laneburg resigned.

The Governor appointed and commissioned Charles W. Howard Brigadier General 11th Brigade 4th Division M. M. vice Joshua Taylor resigned. He also appointed and commissioned Canille L. Stansbury Col vice Howard promoted. James Carroll Jr Lt Col vice Stansbury promoted and Charles R. Howard Major vice Carroll promoted in 46th Regiment 11th Brigade 4th Division M. M.

The Governor appointed and commissioned John Walton. Aide-Camp to his Excellency with the rank of Colonel.

January 25th 1849.
