The Governor issued the following requisition to the Governor of the State of New York.

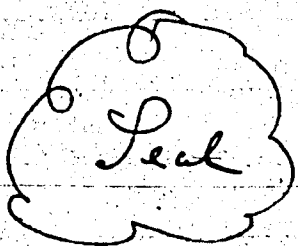
State of Maryland. To wit:
