

March 12th 1851

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Augustus P. Shuttle Justice of the peace to reside on the City of Baltimore, vice V. Christ resigned, and refused a requisition to Geo. W. Graham, because no evidence was adduced that the party was a fugitive from justice.

March 14th 1851

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Onisimus Wailes Justice of the peace for Somerset County, vice Greenbury Holt refused to qualify; also this day appointed and commissioned Robert Pop of Md Justice of the peace for Allegany county, vice Henry Miller declined.

March 15th 1851

✓ The Governor this day, upon the recommendation of Judges Marshall & Weisel, the entire Jury, and many other respectable citizens of Frederick County, pardoned Thomas Smith convicted in the March term of the Frederick County Court, 1851, for stealing a pair of shoes and sentenced to the Penitentiary for eighteen months.

March 17th 1851

This day the Governor appointed and commissioned A. C. Matthews Auctioneer for the City of Baltimore, vice Samuel H. Gover who failed to renew his license as required by law.

March 18th 1851

The Governor this day received the report of James C. Hyland, Inspector of Foreign and Domestic Liquors from the 1st day of July 1850 to the 1st of January 1851.

March 20th 1851

The Governor this day refused to issue a Warrant for the apprehension of John S. Mitchell, who is charged by the Grand Jury of Philadelphia City and County, with the crime of Kidnapping a certain Joel Henry Thompson... see the Requisition of the Governor of Pennsylvania, dated 24th of February 1851, and also the correspondence and other papers in relation thereto.

March 21st 1851

This day the Governor refused to pardon Francis Metz, of Baltimore City, tried in the Baltimore City Court, January term, 1851, and convicted of Manslaughter & sentenced to the Penitentiary.

March 22nd 1851

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Frederick Hinds 2nd Lt. 1st Baltimore German Taylor Light Dragoons 5th Regiment, Cavalry Md. M., also Matthias Benzinger Lieutenant Colonel, George W. R. Bouldin, Captain, Geo. J. Zimmerman 1st Lieutenant, Augustus Ballouff 2^d Lieutenant, Thomas Montgomery 3^d Lieutenant, of the Independent Light Dragoons; George C. Pfeltz, ^{deputy} Quarter Master, vice Gethings, promoted, and Charles A. Leas, Surgeon, 5th Regiment, Cavalry Md. M.
