

November 1st 1851

The Governor this day issued the following requisition
State of Maryland - To wit:

Enoch Louis Lowe, Governor of the State of Maryland,

To His Excellency, the Governor of New York.

It appears by the annexed paper, duly authenticated according to the laws of this State, that a certain Richard Hornier, stands charged upon the affidavit of a certain Charles H. Tilghman with the crime of Larceny, and it has been represented to me that he has fled from the justice of this State, and has taken refuge within the State of New York:

Now therefore pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and Laws of the United States in such case made and provided, I do hereby request that the said Richard Hornier be apprehended and delivered to the said Charles H. Tilghman who is hereby duly authorized to receive and convey him to the State of Maryland there to be dealt with according to law.

November 3rd 1851

The Governor this day pardoned James Beckett, Joseph Murrey, John Sleighter, Casper Hornswell, Henry Edmondson and Henry Hawn who were convicted before Edward Dubois, one of the Justices of the peace of the State of Maryland, in and for Anne Arundel County, on the 22nd day of October 1851 of violating the Act of Assembly passed December Session 1833 Chap. 254 and its several supplements and adjudged to pay a fine of five dollars each, in default of which they were severally put to jail. November 10th 1851

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Nathaniel Duke, Clerk of Calvert County Court, vice Augustus R. Solles resigned.

November 13th 1851

The Governor this day received and filed a copy of the Official Bond of Nathaniel Duke, as Clerk of the Calvert County Court.

November 17th 1851

The Governor this day received a communication from Benjamin Elgott Register of Wills for Anne Arundel County, announcing the death of B. Stevens Gambrell, member elect to the Orphans Court of said County.
